For over 50 years, Vanier Children's Services' mission has been to improve the lives of infants, children, youth and their families through the provision of mental health services and support based on clinical excellence, collaboration, partnerships, and system leadership. Appointed as "Lead Agency for Child/Youth Mental Health (CYMH) System Management" in London-Middlesex County (2014), Vanier is also accountable for community-wide Child/Youth Mental Health System Planning (MCYS: "Moving on Mental Health").

Reporting to the Board of Directors, the Executive Director will provide visionary leadership to drive the mission of the organization, while collaborating with affiliated agencies to plan for improved Children/Youth Mental Health services within London-Middlesex County.

London is designated under the French Language Services Act, requiring the "active offer" of bilingual mental health care. Vanier works with its partners to improve French service capacity. Several Indigenous Communities reside within Middlesex County, whose residents Vanier both serves, and with whom Vanier strives to create collaborative connections. The Executive Director will have an understanding of these communities and appreciation of the diverse population of London and surrounding area.

In alignment with Vanier Children's Services' mission and vision, the Executive Director will provide strategic oversight and guidance to key internal and external stakeholders in planning, implementation, and evaluation of the agency's services, while supporting the organization's culture with thoughtful direction and guidance. The Executive Director will champion the agency's status as a training centre of choice for various educational institutions.

The Executive Director will safeguard a positive, inclusive, and accessible work environment for staff, ensuring appropriate training necessary to meet the organization's high professional standards. Additionally, this senior leader will support budgeting processes, monitor revenues and expenditures and assess risk management concerns.

The Executive Director will be a passionate, strategic leader with an engaging vision for continuing and executing the existing organizational strategies. Acting as the designated spokesperson for the Lead Agency, the Executive Director will liaise with community CYMH leaders and work in partnership with local government representatives to better serve the needs of the community. The Executive Director will also advocate for improved awareness and resources to support a more robust provision of mental health services for infants, children, youth, and their families.

Preferably, you will have experience working in a unionized, clinical environment with a demonstrated awareness regarding child and youth mental health.
