Program Summary

This casual call-in position is available to work within the residential programs – day, afternoon, nights and weekend nights shifts; the treatment classrooms, Day Respite, and the Family Bridges program as required. The Relief Staff is responsible to provide supervision and care for the children within the program and to assume the duties described in the job description for the position they are replacing, excluding the primary worker responsibilities. With the completion of the “Respite Certificate”, relief staff is eligible for day respite and ‘Community Bridges’ shifts/contracts.
