The Data Analyst has a key role in ensuring evaluation processes that enhance evidence-based decision-making. The Data Analyst assists the Director of Quality Improvement in planning, designing, implementing, and maintaining integrated databases, as well as managing data from other agencies within the London-Middlesex service area. The Data Analyst provides user-support related to Vanier databases for staff and managers within Vanier, and the Data Analyst consults to other agencies within the London-Middlesex service area regarding data management. The Data Analyst generates and interprets data reports as needed by stakeholders and trains stakeholders to access and interpret data. The Data Analyst not only extracts data from existing databases but also supports the creation of both ongoing quality improvement tools and project-specific surveys. The Data Analyst has the primary role in data visualization and statistical analysis.
